Workplace visit

During the workplace visit, the 2nd-graders think about working.

They actually go to a workplace, and can consider occupations for their future.

Each 2nd-grader goes to one workplace out of seven to learn the purpose of working.

When they go there, they are also able to learn the manner of society.

There is an opportunity to listen to a store of from a person who works there.

They can learn about the work environment and equipment because each work environment is different .

They get on a bus to go to diverse workplaces.

They can go diverse to workplaces, such as a hospital, meteorological observatory, and nursery school.

They can learn action policy in the Japan Coast Guard.

They learn about action policy, and they learn about other work.

They can visit actual work places.

From this, 2nd-graders can learn "What working is like by visiting a workplace?"

It also makes them enhance awareness of working.

2nd-graders can find out its achievement or difficulties through asking questions to workers and working with them actually.
